Furry heirs:

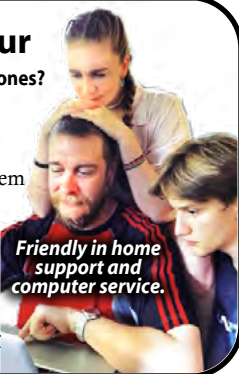

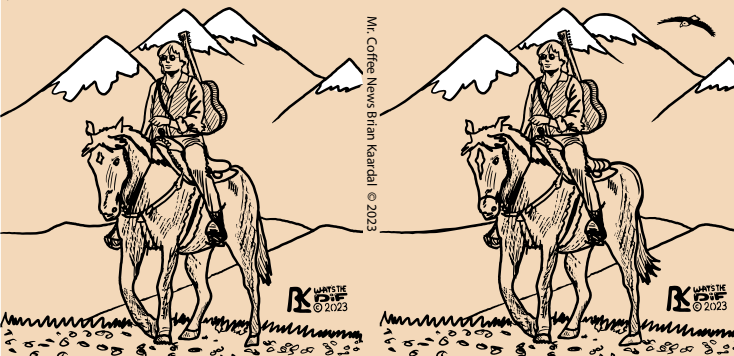
